WAY 1

1. Look at the poster, the title and the post. **Pay attention** to the source and **say** what the video might be about.

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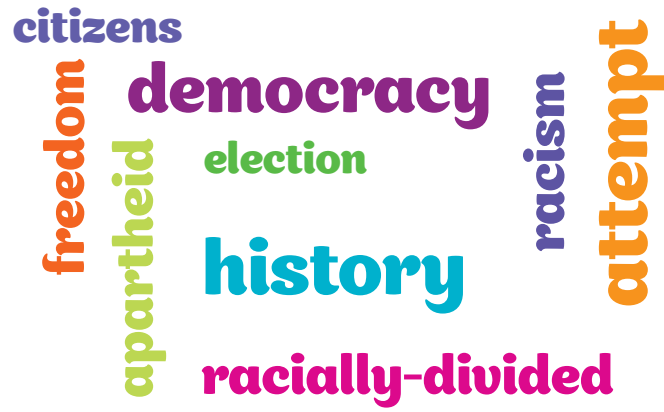
2. Watch the video. **Pay attention** to the various speakers heard and **identify** the main topic of the report.
