B1	Redi Thlabi explains how there are still some remaining issues today in South Africa. Many people are poor and suffer from inequality. He explains that Nelson Mandela did his best but that it's everybody's responsibility to try and change things.

They have learnt to condemn racism. According to Thlabi, there are still remaining inequalities in South Africa and even the younger generations need to do their part to change that.	C
